It serves its Member states as an advisory body, and as a forum to facilitate the exchange of views and information on legal matters of common concern to its Member States. AALCO is organising a seminar on "Climate Change: Post-Kyoto International Climate Policy" on 16 January 2013, at AALCO Headquarters, New Delhi, India from 10.00 AM to 04.45 PM.
