Mr. Zhu Yong is the Deputy Secretary General of AALCO since November, 2023. He is seconded by the Government of the People's Republic of China.

He once served as legal officer in the Asia Pacific Regional Office of the Hague Conference in Private International Law in Hong Kong SAR, and once worked in the Embassy of China in the Republic of Malta.

Mr. Zhu holds a Master's Degree of Common Law from the University of Hong Kong as well as a Master's Degree of Law from Renmin University of China.
